The tournament draws 32 top male players to Newport direct from Wimbledon to compete for the Van Alen Cup and \$442,500 in prize money. Players scheduled to compete include No. 3 American Sam Querrey, No. 6 American Mardy Fish, No. 8 American Rajeev Ram and No. 9 American Taylor Dent. Hosted on the legendary grass courts of the International Tennis Hall of Fame & Museum, the Campbell's Hall of Fame Tennis Championships is the only ATP World Tour event played on grass in North America. In conjunction with the tournament, the International Tennis Hall of Fame & Museum will host the annual Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony on Saturday, July 10.

About the Architectural Symposium

The Newport Casino, which now houses the International Tennis Hall of Fame at 194 Bellevue Avenue, is a National Historic Landmark, representing one of the finest examples of American shingle style architecture. The third annual Architecture Symposium, sponsored by Woodmeister Master Builders, will be held on Saturday, May 7, 2011.
